JUNIOR AND SENIOR COMPANY BALLET CLASSES OPEN TO ALL PUPILS

These classes are now open to any students who wish to progress and develop with classical ballet. They involve greater concentration on technique and a chance to develop artistry, and are 'free work' classes, meaning there is no set ISTD syllabus work. The Junior class is grade 2-4 and the Senior class is grade 5 upwards. The Company classes are not included in the family fee. Please contact Miss Jayne if your child wishes to join.

UNIFORM

Belts MUST be worn. Hair must be in a bun for ballet and G3 modern upwards, and back in a very tidy ponytail for all other classes. There should be no stray hair in the

face. Please tuck in ballet-shoe laces. No watches, rings, necklaces, bracelets. Melanie can provide all your dancewear requirements and we even have her <u>fabulous video on how to do the perfect ballet bun</u>. Why not have a look! This will be a great help to Baby Ballet parents! JMDS red zip hoodies can be ordered directly from me. They are £29 and sizes are by age. If you wish to order, please let me know the age of your child. Deadline for orders is 12^{th} April.

Payment of Fees – conditions, deadlines and how to pay – PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

No invoices are sent out. All fees can be seen on the Timetable & Fees page on the website

- > Bank transfers are welcome. Sort code: 30–94–08 Account: 01097687
- > Cheques payable to J Wilson please and not JMDS or Jayne Marie Dancing School
- > Cash MUST be the exact money in a named, securely sealed envelope. Teachers do not give change.
- Please note that I require one month's notice in writing if a child no longer wants the class place. You have agreed to this when signing your child's registration form and these are kept on file as proof of your agreement. You will be subject to half a term's fees should this notice not be given. Notice must not be given verbally to teachers; it should bein writing or email to Miss Jayne: <u>missjayne@jmdancingschool.com</u>. This is usual practice for established dance schools.
- > All fees are due on the first lesson of term, but you have two weeks to pay before a surcharge is made.
- You may give your payment to teachers, post directly to me, or pay by bank transfer. Teachers only collect in the first two weeks of term, so please bring the money with you on the first lesson or ensure your child takes it with him/her to hand in toany teacher. No payment should be given to teachers after Saturday 7th May
- All fees must be in my office by Sunday 8th May. Late fee letters will be posted/emailed on the morning on Monday 9th May and the surcharge will apply to all fees not received by the deadline. Please ensure bank transfers reach the account in time and do not leave it until the last minute!
- Unfortunately, I am often chasing fees after half term, therefore we impose an extra charge of 10% of total fees, for those which are not in the office by the deadline. It is your responsibility to ensure payment reaches Miss Jayne by the deadline otherwise the 10% will be added. You accept the responsibility for this extra charge by your child attending classes at JMDSand no parent is exempt. Deadlines are strict.
